With the rise of Christian Nationalism and religious-based attacks on our bodily autonomy multi-faith collaboration and learning is needed more than ever:

Within the world's religions are bedrock ethics, narratives, beliefs, and rituals that support justice, human rights, liberation from all oppression, and community flourishing. This curriculum is an invitation for people of faith to constructively wrestle with the relationship between the ethical principles of Reproductive Justice and both the oppressive and liberative aspects of their religious traditions.
